Job responsibilities include identifying patients' needs and acting on them, monitoring vital parameters, providing drugs, preparing patients for examinations and treatments and last but not least providing a compassionate environment for the patients.

## Offers

- To start the position you are required to master Swedish corresponding to level C1. For suitable candidates we will provide Swedish classes, in some cases in your home country, followed by more advanced classes upon arrival in Sweden.
- We will help you during the first period with accommodation, you will have a mentor at the hospital and help with practicalities.
- You work full time with 25 days paid holiday
- Starting wages appr. 2 400 – 2 600/month plus supplement for inconvenient working hours
- Continuous in-house training
